Community Exhibition

First Hydro Company will be holding an open exhibition and drop-in session from **2.00pm – 8.00pm on Tuesday 17th April at Electric Mountain Visitor Centre** for residents and other local stakeholders to find out more about the redevelopment project. Representatives from the development team will be available to answer your questions and provide information on the proposed redevelopment, along with other graphics and illustrations.

The exhibition will then remain open to the public from **Wednesday 18th April, 10.00am – 4.30pm up to and including Friday 20th April**. Although the exhibition itself will not be manned during this time, Diane Rowlands (Visitor Centre Manager) will be available, on site, if you would like to speak with her.
