We offer electricity generation services to our customers in a competitive and dynamic market. Our Visitor Centre in Llanberis, known as Electric Mountain, provides an educational experience for the public.

Working within close proximity to areas of outstanding natural beauty, the Company upholds the highest levels of environmental awareness, responsibility and integrity.
